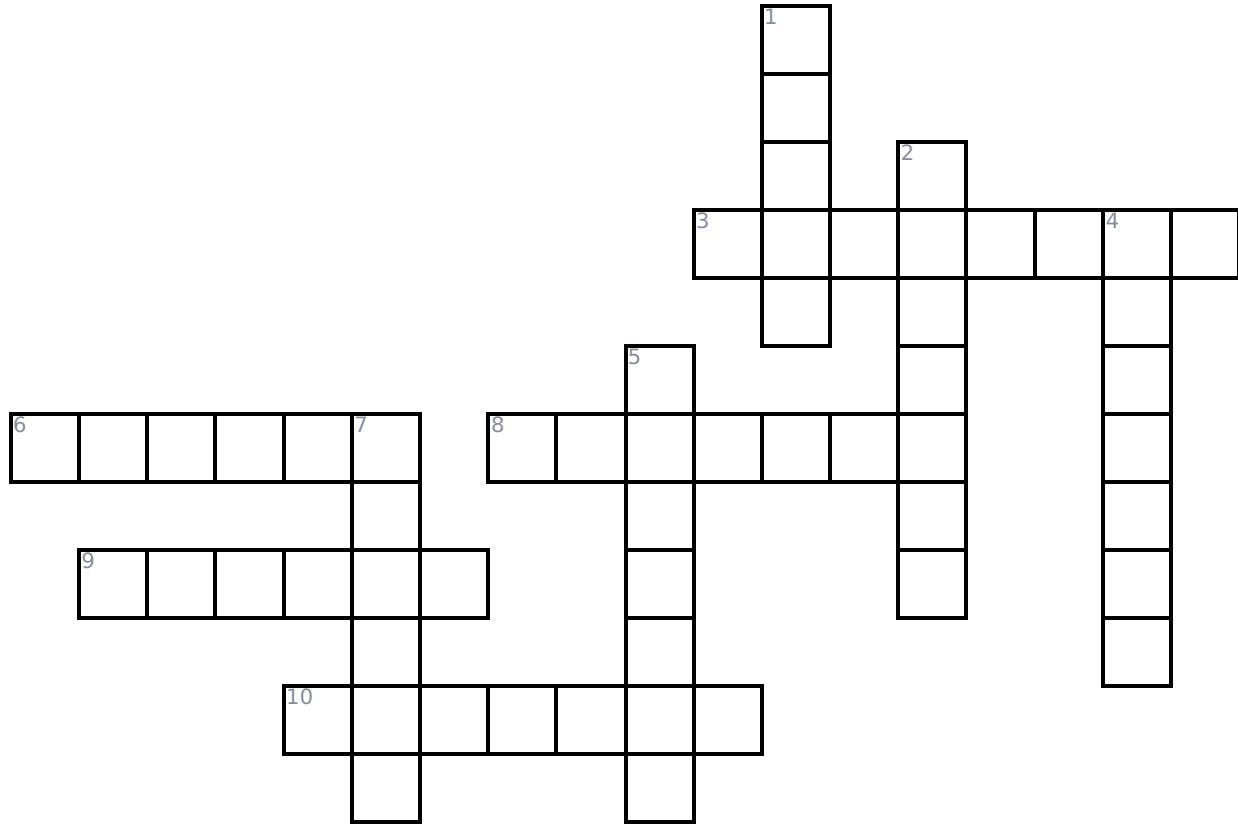


Bad Boy: Criss Cross
