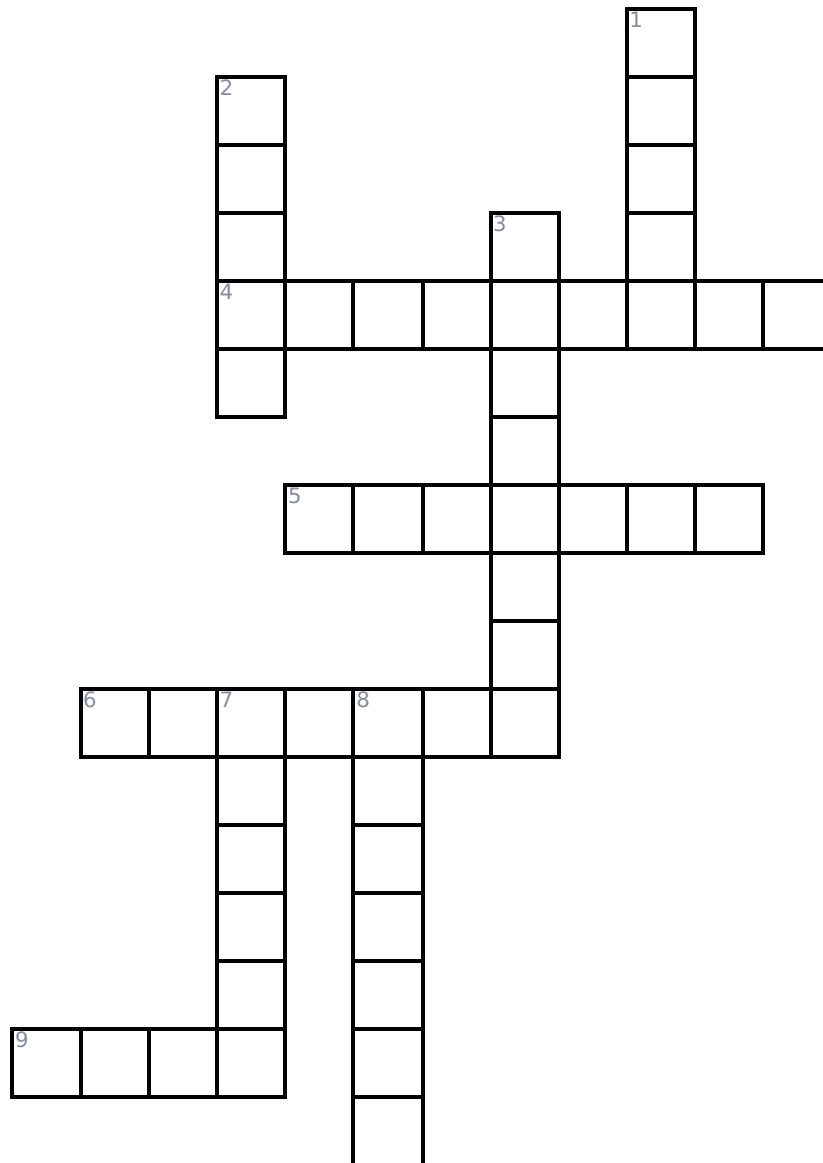


## **I Am Malala: How One Girl Stood Up for Education and Changed the World: Criss Cross**
