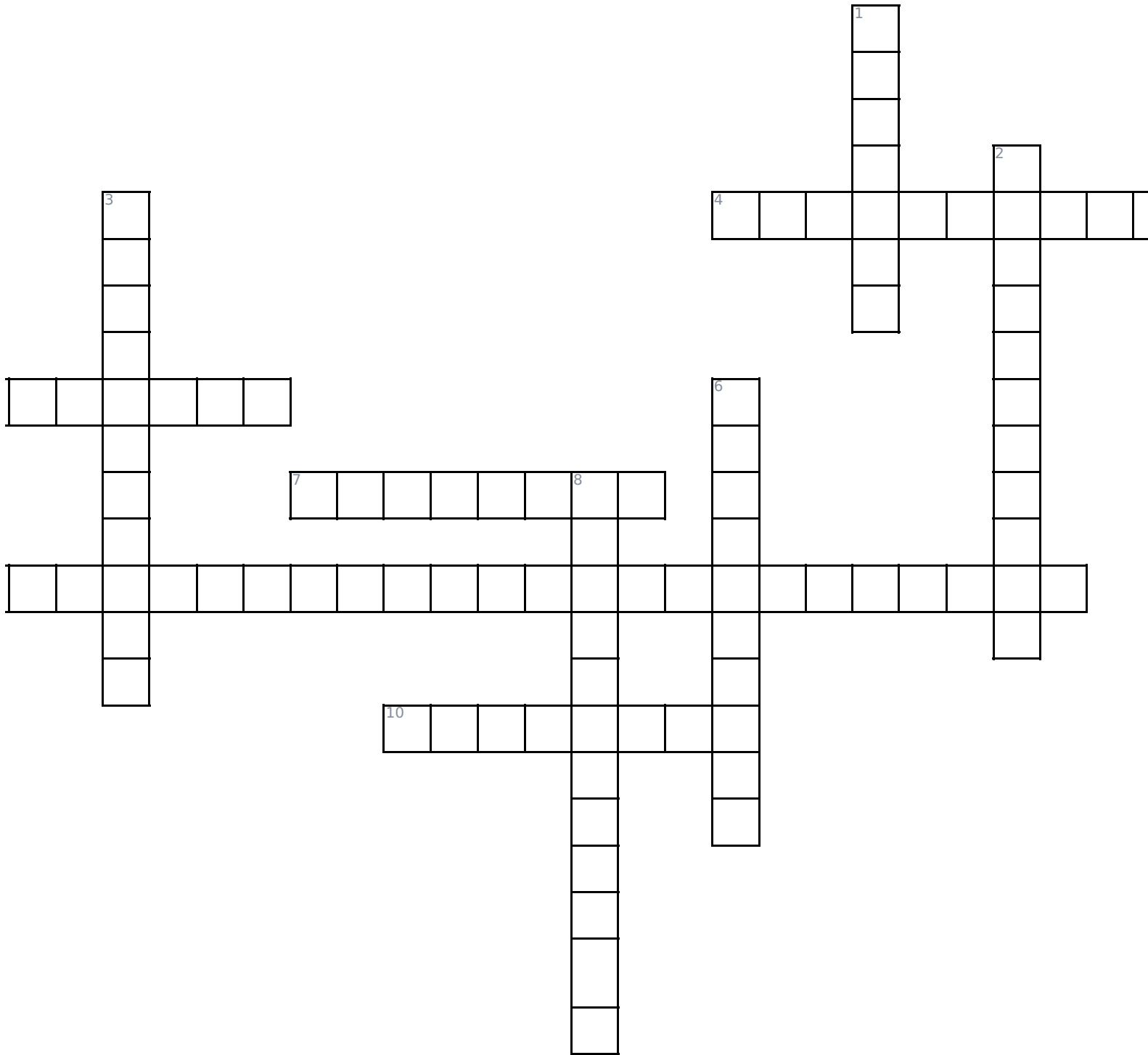
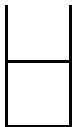


The Juneteenth Story: Criss Cross
