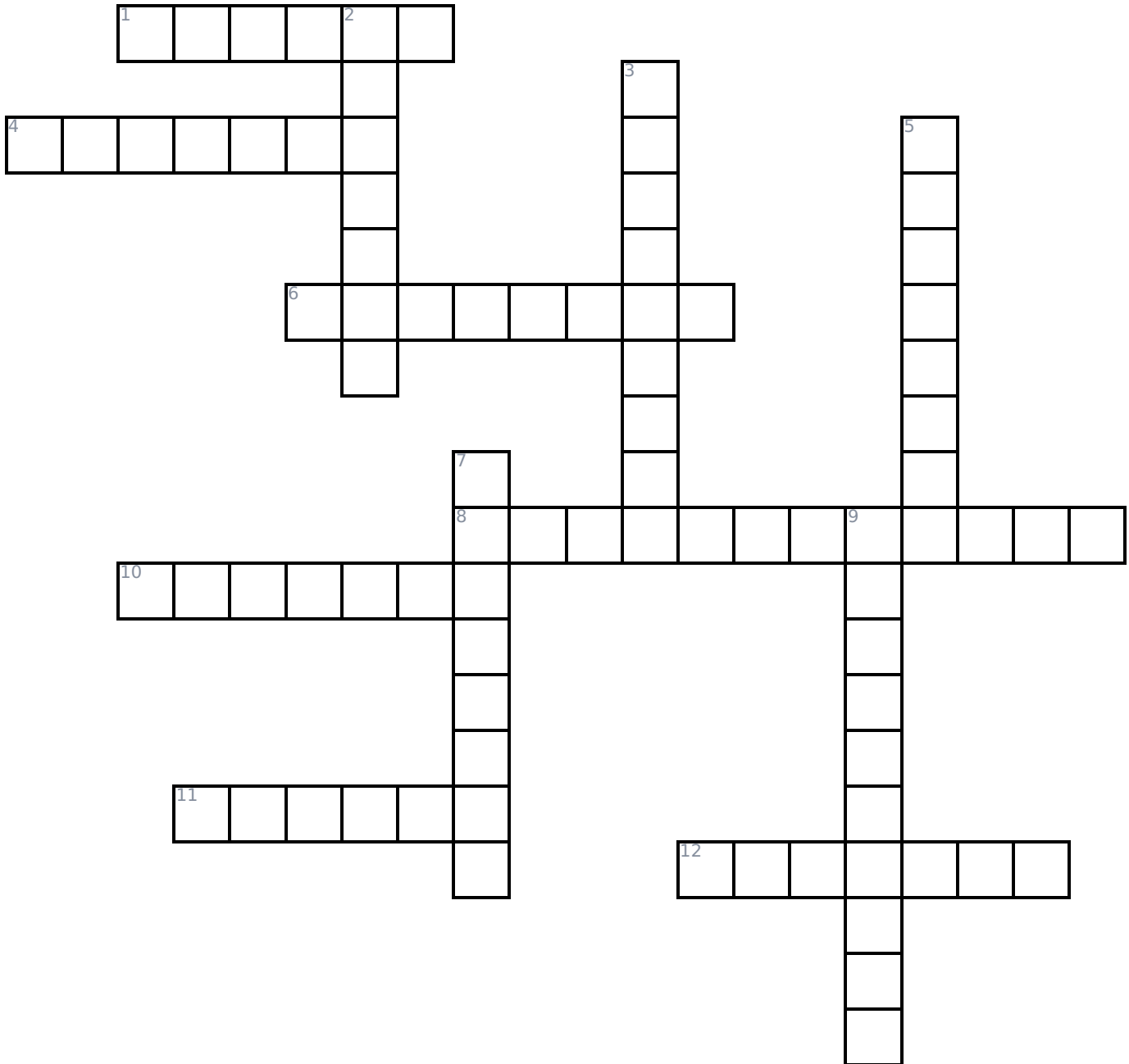


**Lewis and Clark Map the American West
