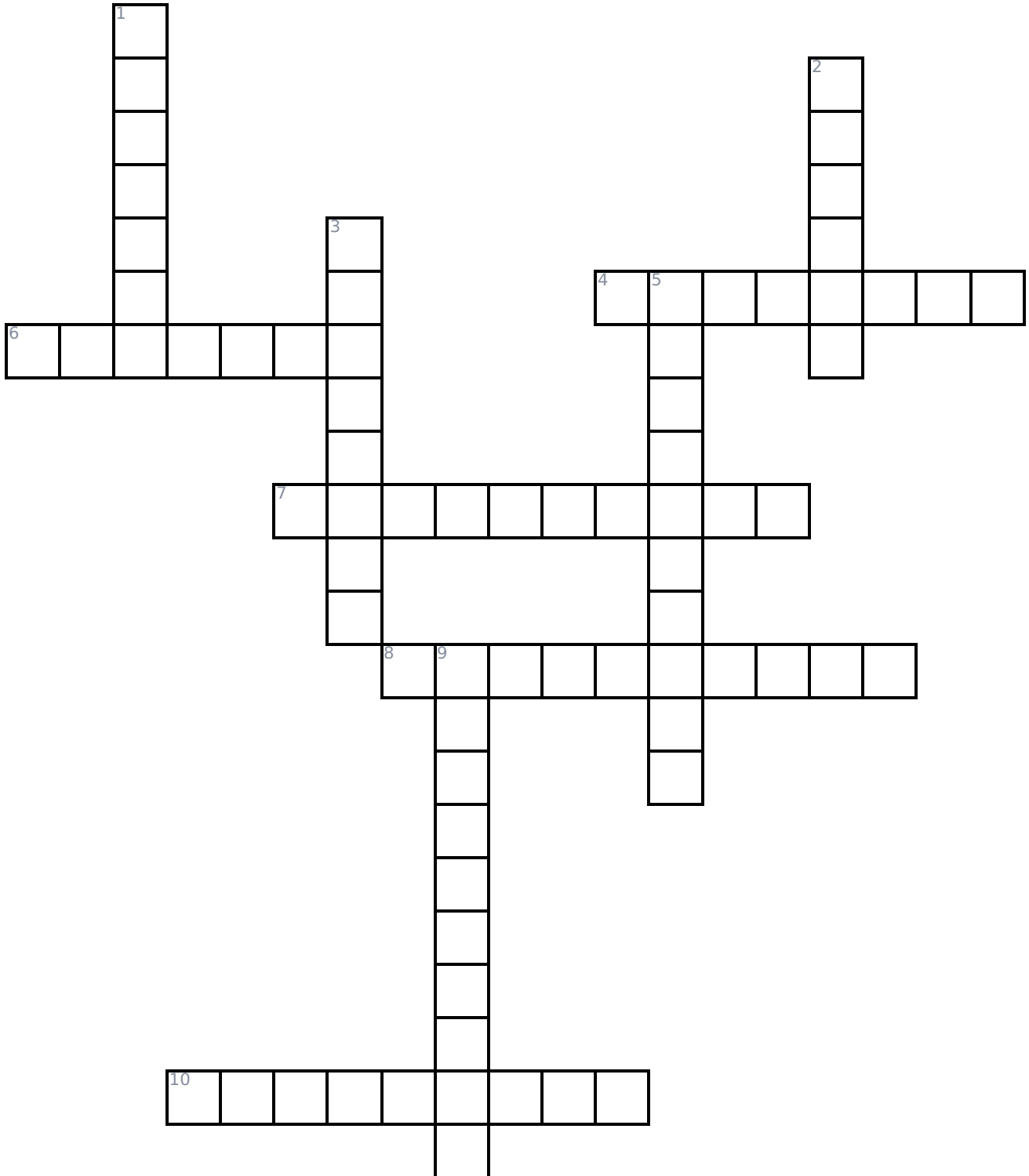


Monster: Criss Cross
