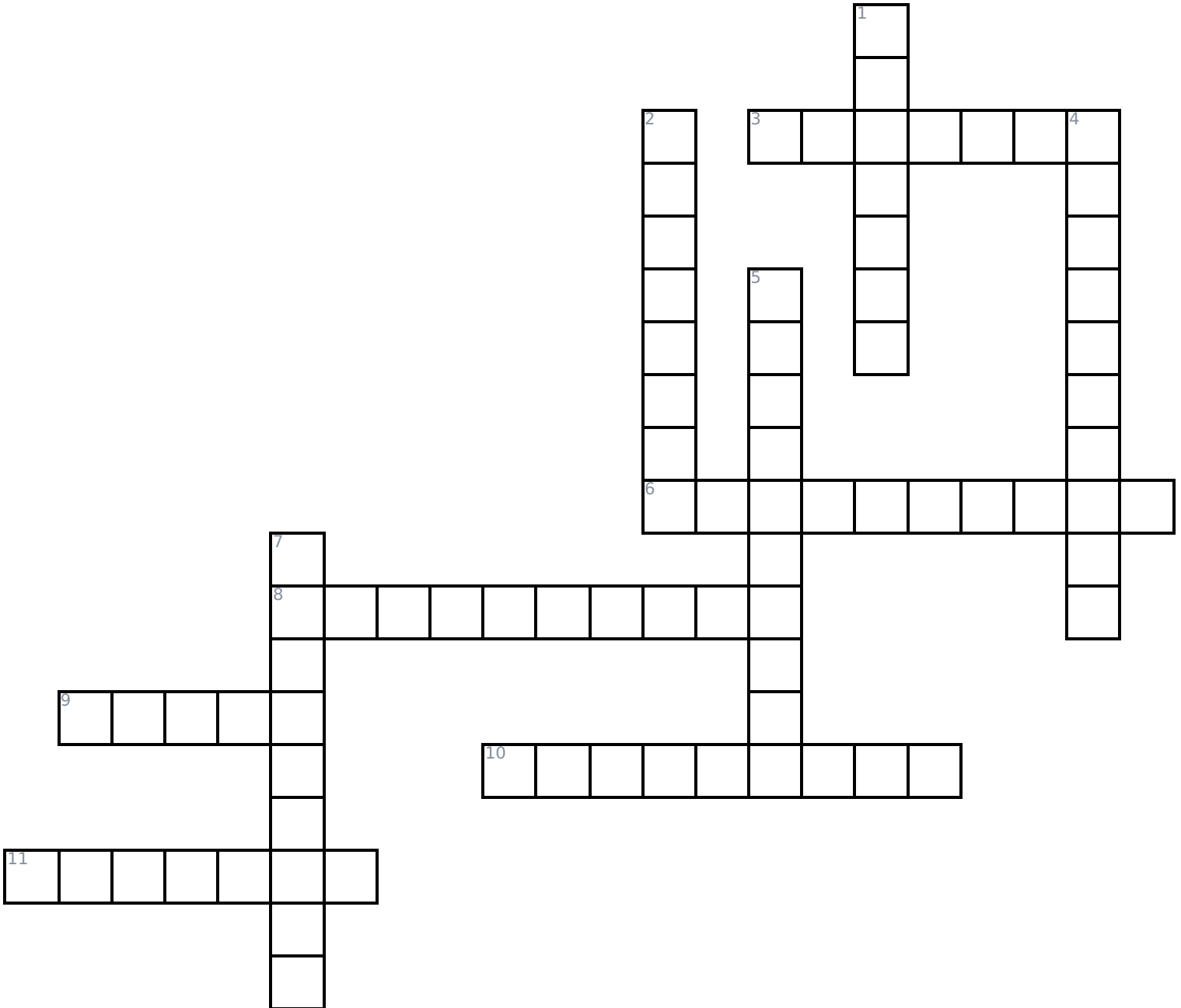


Nat Geo Kids Get Outside: Criss Cross
