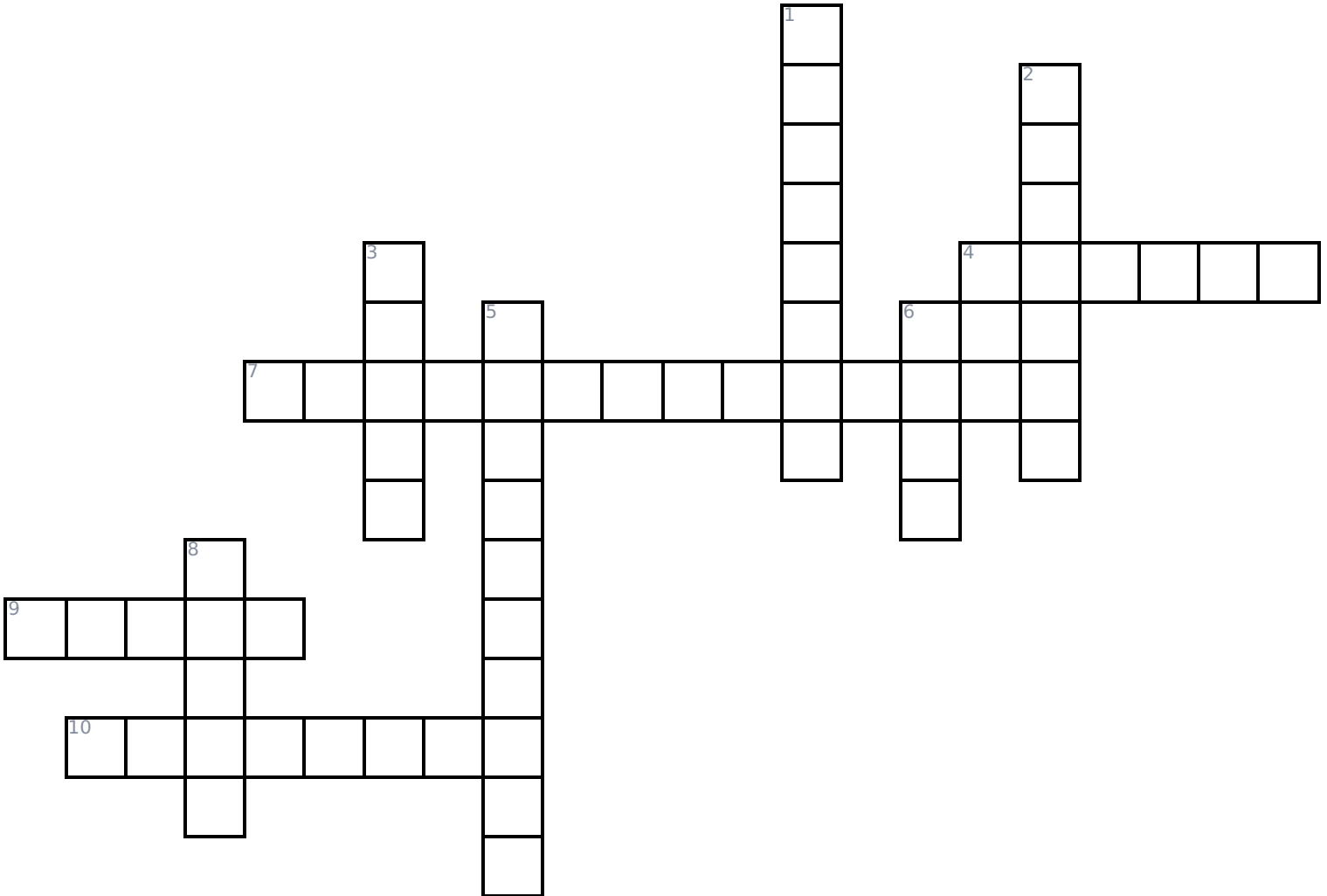


## National Geographic Readers: Night Sky: Criss Cross
