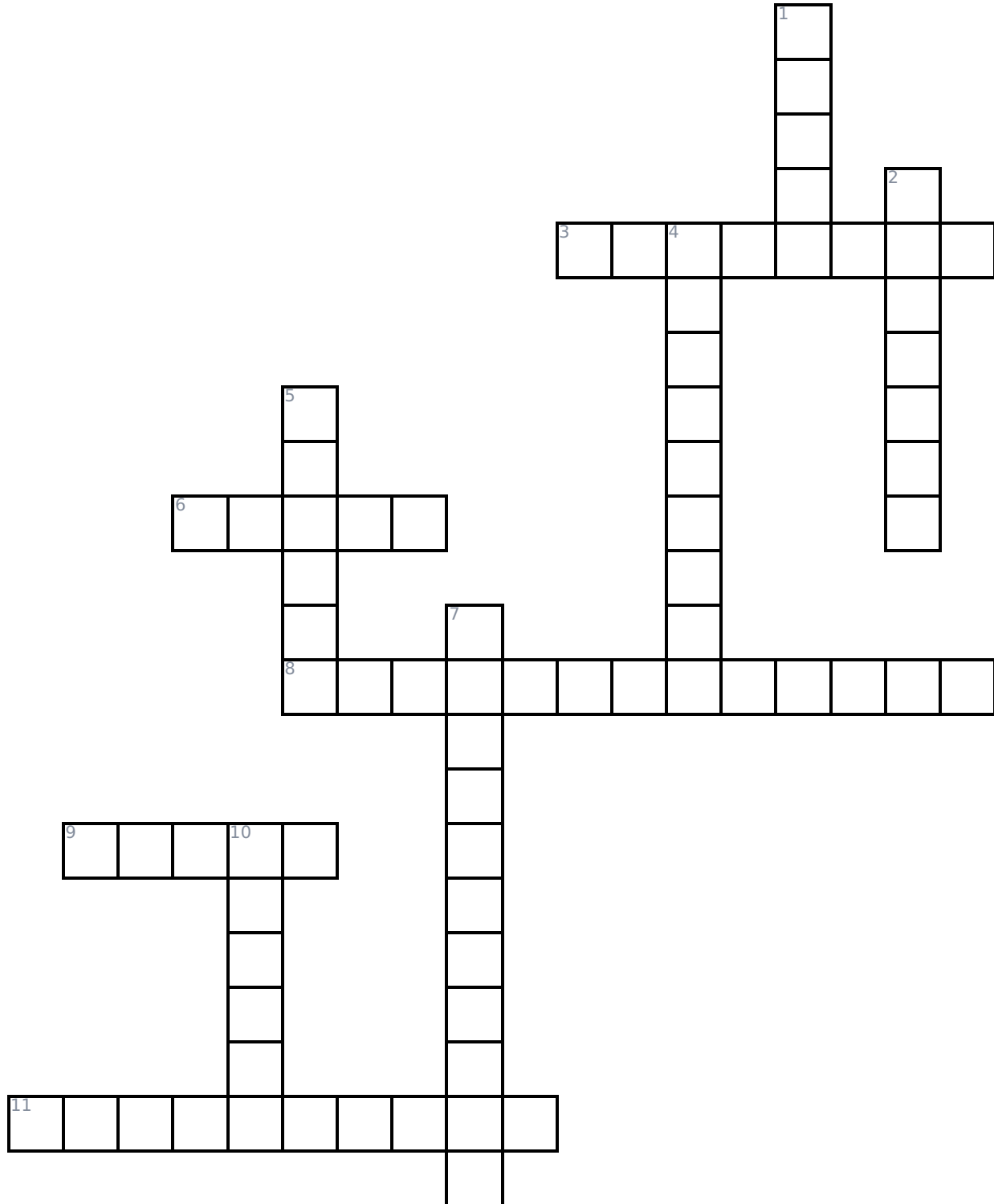


Nothing But the Truth: Criss Cross
