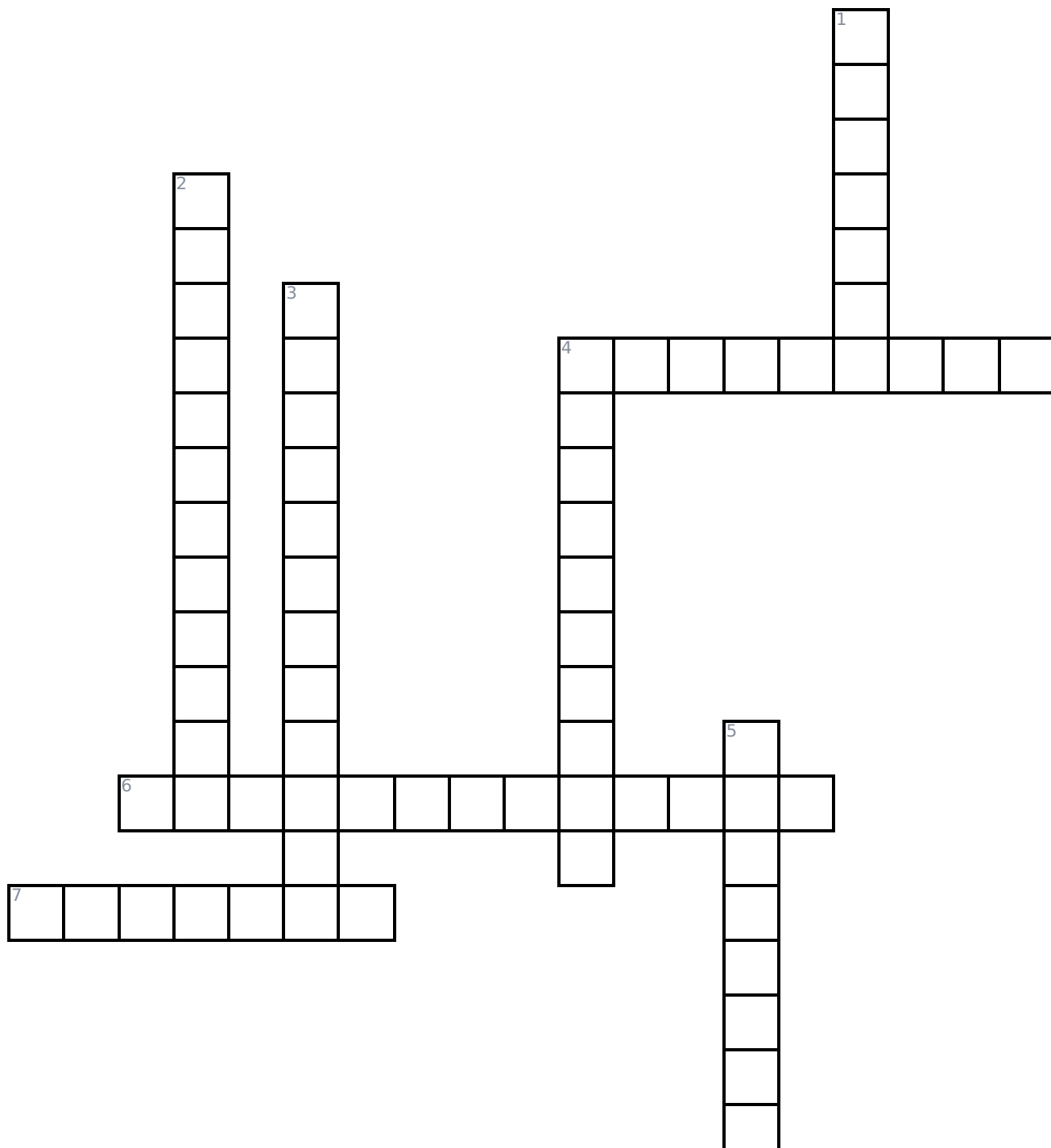


## Rachel Carson: Criss Cross
