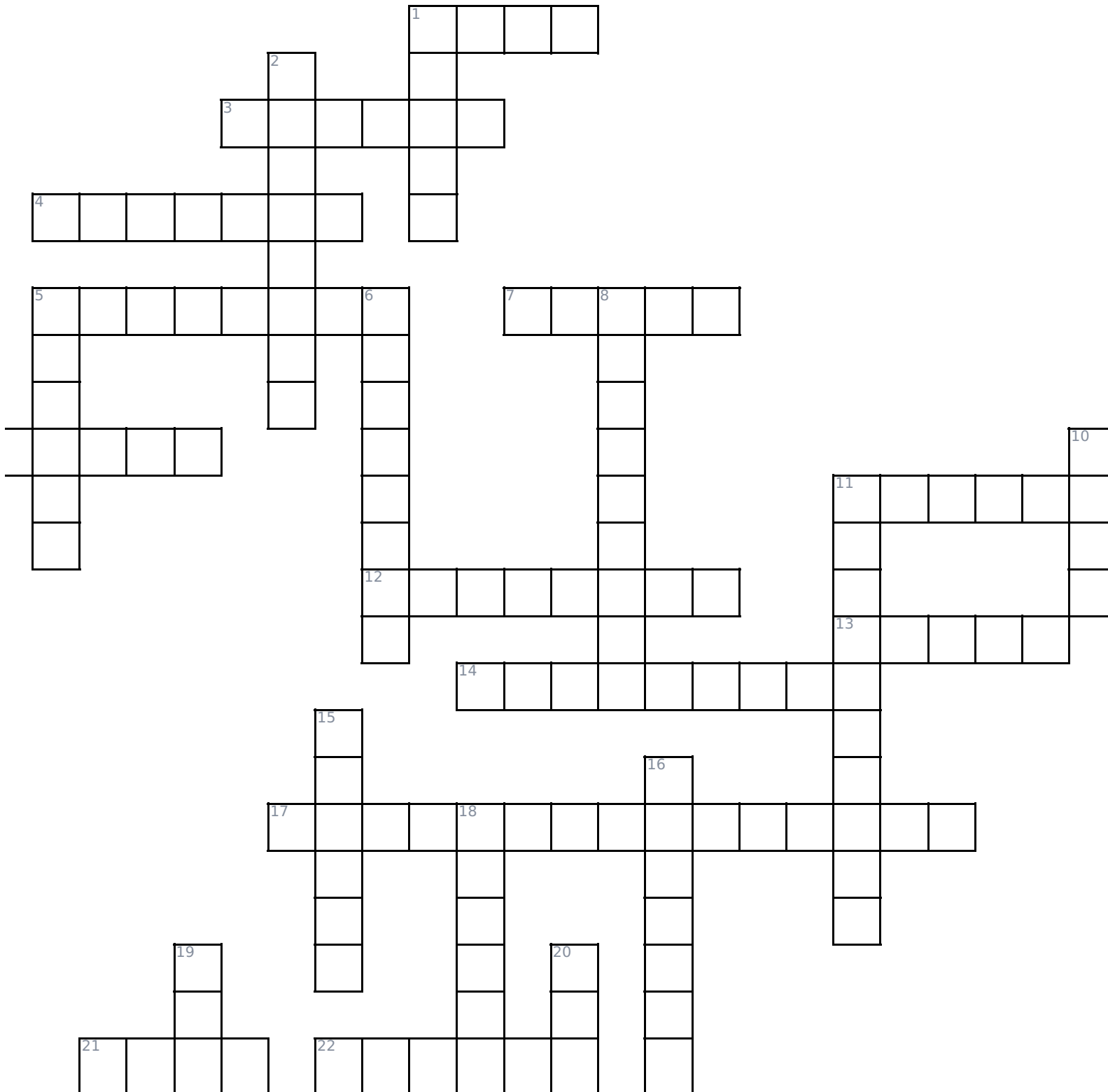
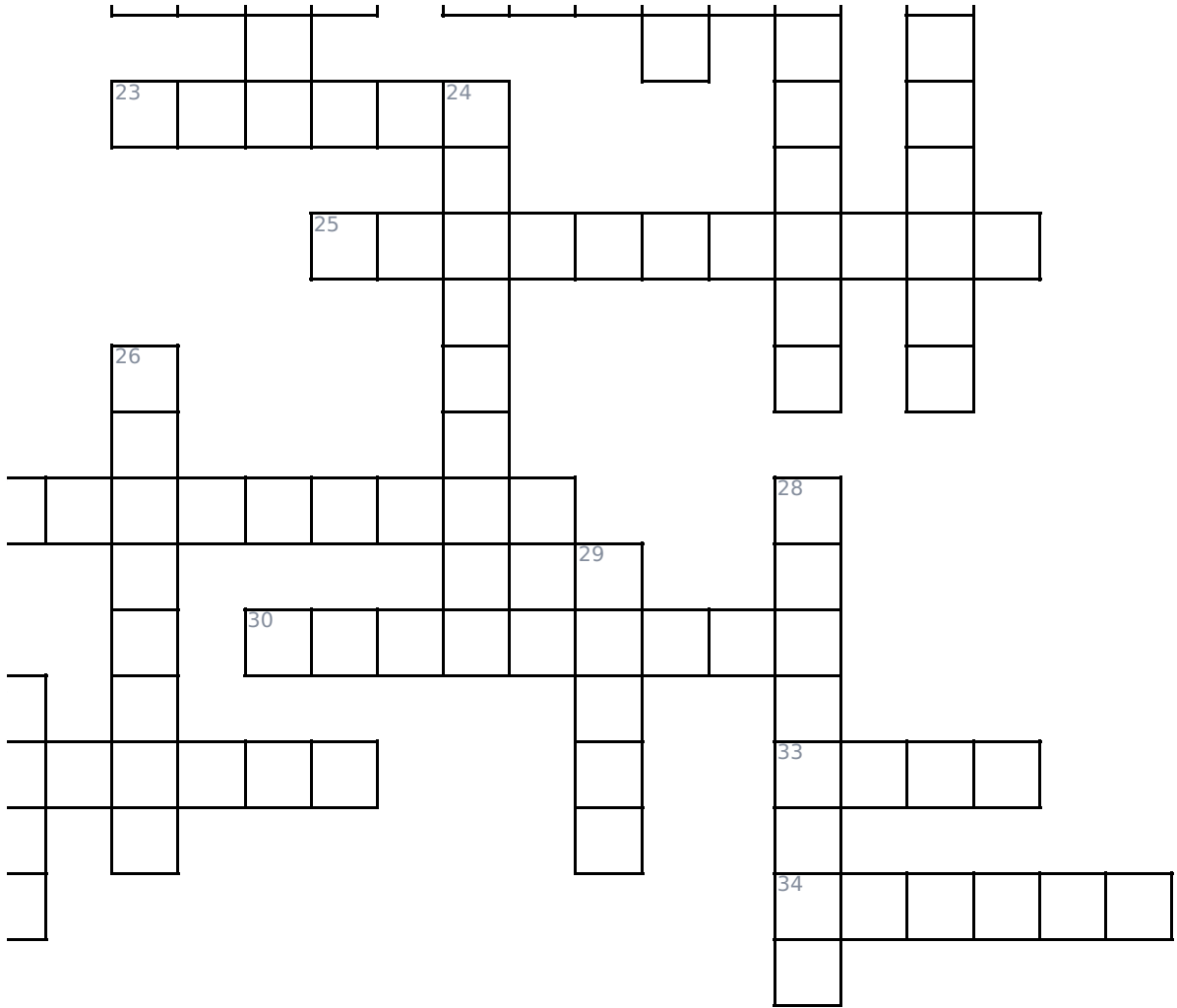


## The STEAM Team: Criss Cross (Medium)
