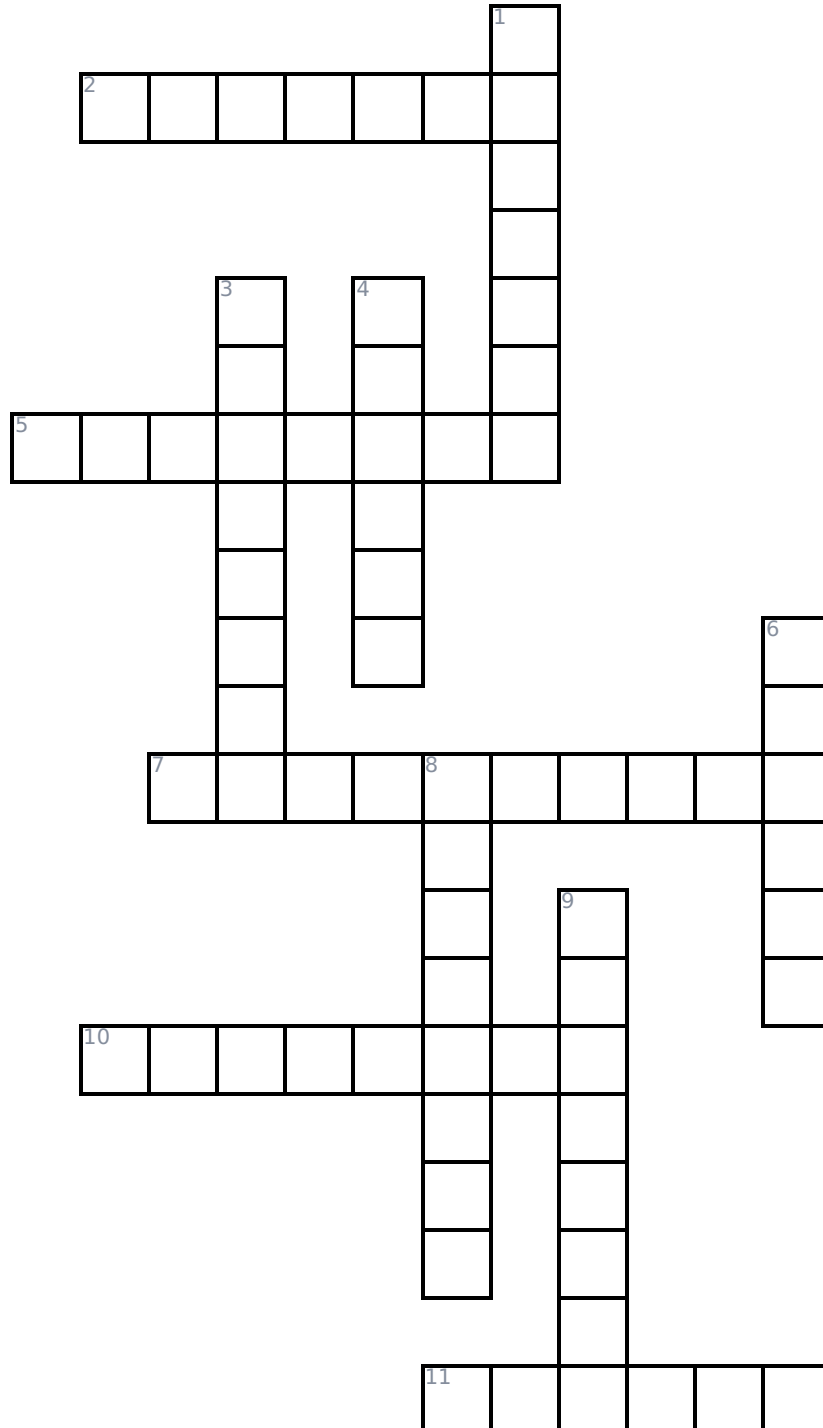


Ultimate Bodypedia: Criss Cross
