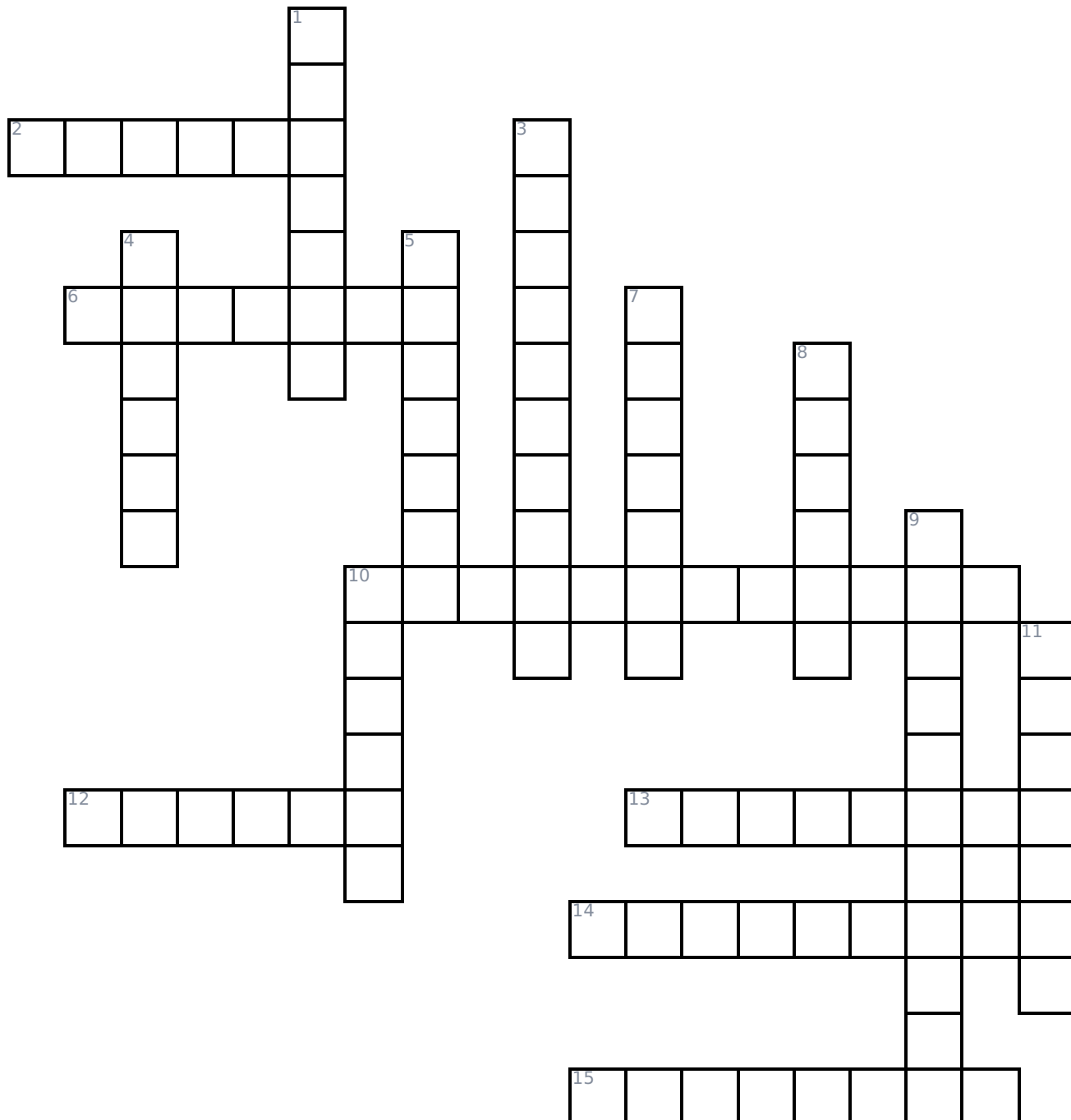


What Is Juneteenth?: Criss Cross
