

'Twas The Night Before Thanksgiving


READ ALOUD GUIDE

Themes: Friendship, Thanksgiving

Book Brief: On the day before Thanksgiving, children visit a turkey farm and meet Farmer Mack Nuggett and his lively cockerels. They giggle and gobble together, leaving with full hearts and bellies, celebrating all they have to be thankful for.

BEFORE READING

The Cover: Have students make predictions about the story based on the cover.

The Pictures: Take a brief picture walk and ask students what they notice about the children.

Prior Knowledge: Ask students, "Have you ever seen a turkey before? What would you do if you met one?" (Optional: think, pair, share)

Vocabulary: Frontload Tier 2 words using the accompanying Vocabulary Guide.

Purpose for Reading: "As we read today, pay attention to the children's reaction to the turkeys."

DURING READING

Check for understanding & make connections:

- How would you describe the children? What character traits would you use?
- Compare how the children felt at the beginning of the book compared to the end. What did they learn that changed their feelings?

AFTER READING

Our Purpose: The children loved playing with the turkeys. Explain what the children learned what they did.

Extending Our Thinking: The children saved the turkeys. Using RIF's Create A Character, have students create a disguise for the turkey and explain how it would blend in.

If your students enjoyed this book...

- · Encourage them to continue to discuss it and refer to it in other lessons and conversations.
- Let them explore more about the topic by reading other books with similar themes, structure, characters, or content.
