Optional: Print on cardstock and laminate.

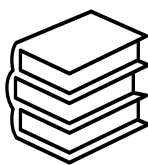
Players: 2-3

How to Play: Each player gets 4 cards. Each player takes a turn to ask another player for a specific card to make a pair. If the player doesn't have the card, they say, "Go Fish!" to draw from the deck.
