Word	Student-friendly definition
hibernate	when an animal sleeps for a long time in winter to stay warm and safe
molt	when an animal takes off its old skin, feathers, or shell and grows new ones
predator	an animal that hunts and eats other animals
prey	animals that get eaten by other animals
pupil	the black circle in the middle of your eye that helps you see
reptile	an animal with dry, scaly skin, like a snake, lizard, or turtle
scute	a hard, bumpy part of a turtle's shell or a reptile's skin
snake	a long, skinny animal with no legs that slithers on the ground
