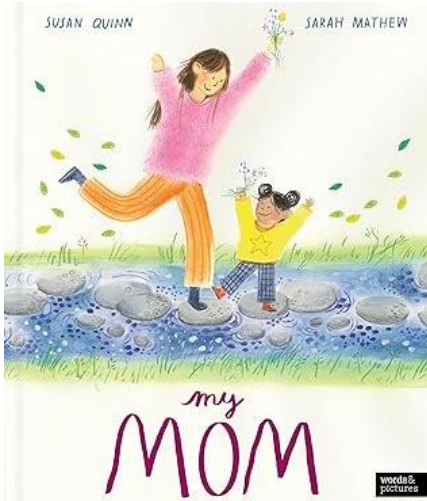


Discussion Guide for Families

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, “What do you like to do with our family?” “What does the title *My Mom* make you think this book will be about?”

While Reading: Make Connections

- How does the little girl feel about her mom? What words or pictures help you know?
- What are some things the mom and daughter do together?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- How is our family like the one in the book? How is it different?
- What did the story teach you about love or family?
