

## Read Aloud Guide for Families

**Themes:** Justice, Family

**Book Brief:** Kiki learns from her mom and makes the world a better place!

## READ ALOUD

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### Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "What is something important that someone in your family has taught you? How do you use what they taught you?"
- Explain to your child that this story is about real events, but it is told like a story with characters, a setting, and events in order.

### While Reading: Make Connections

- What does Kiki learn from her mother? How does her mother teach her?
- How does Kiki feel about fairness and treating people equally?
- Describe how Kiki uses what she learned as she grows up. What does she do to help others?

### After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, "How did the lessons from Kiki's mother help her stand up for what is right and fair?"

## RELATED ACTIVITIES

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### If your child enjoyed this book:

- Make a "Family Lessons Book." Have your child interview family members about important lessons they've learned, then create a small book with drawings and writings about these lessons and how your child can use them too.
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
