READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

 Ask, "Do you have a favorite toy or stuffed animal? What makes it special to you?"

While Reading: Make Connections

- What does Alice's mom want to do? Why does she think this is a good idea?
- How does Alice feel about her toys? What does she say about each one?
- What reasons does Alice give for keeping her toys? Which toy story is your favorite?

After Reading: Ask Questions

 Ask, "Why does Alice want to keep all her toys? What makes each toy special to her? How does the story end?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Make a "My Special Toys" book. Have your child choose 3-5 of their favorite toys and draw pictures of them. Help them write or tell a short story about why each toy is special, just like Alice shared the special memories and reasons she loved each of her toys.
