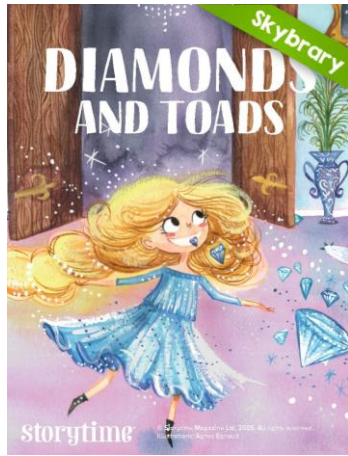


Read Aloud Guide for Families

Book Brief: Two sisters get what they deserve from a wonderful woodland fairy.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, “What is a consequence? What causes one?”

While Reading: Make Connections

- Describe the two sisters. How are they the same or different?
- Why did the sisters get different consequences from the fairy?
- What do you think happened to the mother when she ran off into the woods?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, “What actions led to the sisters' consequences?”

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Ask your child to imagine they could receive a gift from the fairy. What gift would they choose, and why? Talk together about how that gift might help them or change the story. Your child can share their thinking by talking, drawing a picture, or writing a few sentences.
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
