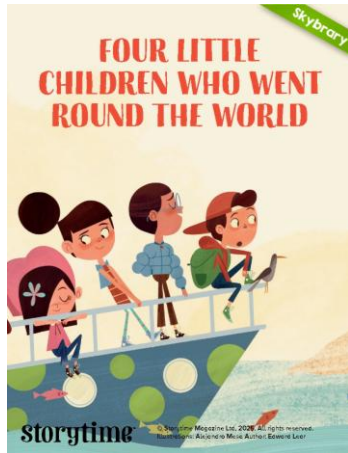


Read Aloud Guide for Families

Themes: Adventure, Friendship, Kindness

Book Brief: A wonderful, silly adventure about four children who sail around the world in a blue boat with green spots and have the most amazing and ridiculous adventures!

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "If you could go on an adventure around the world, what strange and wonderful things would you want to see?"

While Reading: Make Connections

- What do the four children see on their travels? What strange things do they find?
 - What funny or unusual animals do they meet? Which one was your favorite?
- What happens to their boat? How do they get home?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, "What is the main idea of this story? What happens to the four children on their journey? What is the most surprising or magical thing that happens?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Create your own "Magical Adventure Map." Have your child draw or write about an imaginary journey they would like to take. What strange places would they visit? What unusual creatures would they meet? Draw pictures of the adventure.
