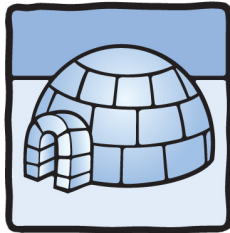
explorers: people who learn about a thing by trying it or who learn about a place by going there
