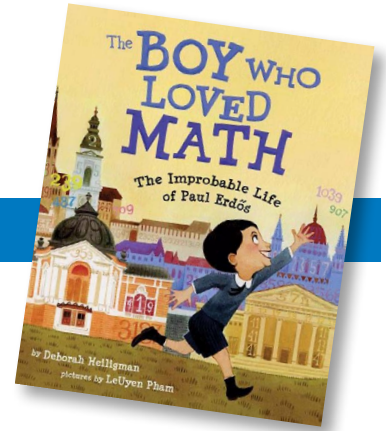

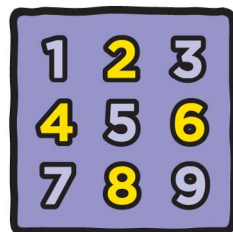


A RIF VOCABULARY SCAFFOLD

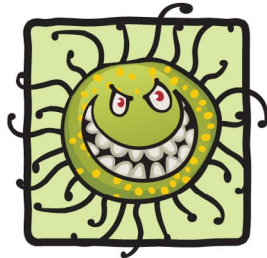
divide: to break something into parts; to find out how many times one number contains another number



even numbers: numbers that can be divided by two into equal whole numbers



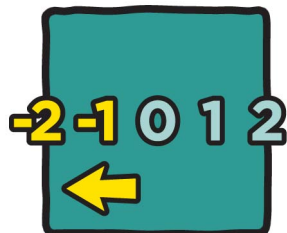
germs: small living things that can make you get sick



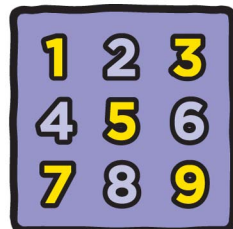
laundry: clothes or other things that are dirty and need to be washed



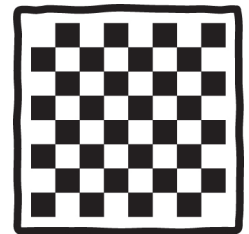
negative numbers: numbers that are less than 0



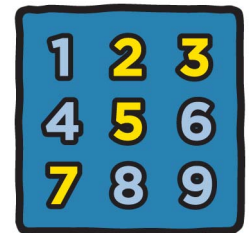
odd numbers: numbers that you can't divide into two equal whole numbers



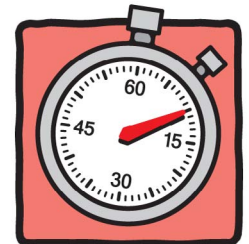
pattern: something that happens the same way many times



prime number: a number (like 2, 3, or 5) that can only be exactly divided by itself and by 1



seconds: a very short time; 1/60 of a minute



subtract: to take something away from something else
