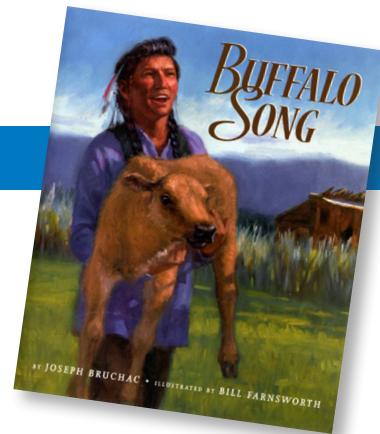
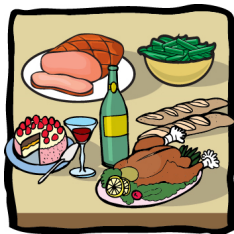

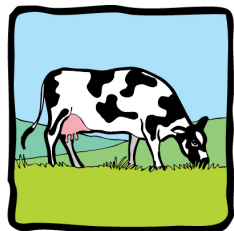
feast: a lot of food;

and horses live



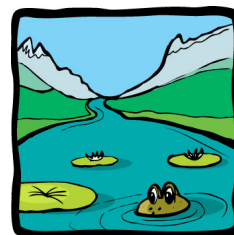
scent: smell
