desert: an area of very dry land, usually very hot and covered in sand or rock



hatch: to come out of an egg



raft: a flat structure used for floating on water






rain forest: a tropical forest that gets a lot of rain and has very tall trees



swamp: land that is always wet and covered partly by water



tadpole: a small animal that becomes an adult frog or toad; it has a rounded body and a long tail, and lives in water



toad: a frog that has dry skin, usually bumpy, and lives on land
