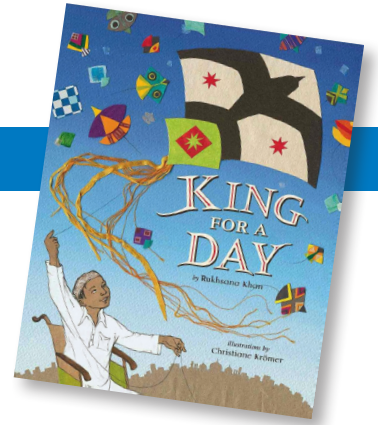
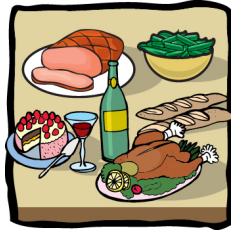

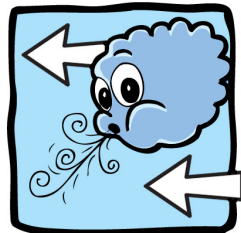
feast: a big meal with a lot of food and drink
