




# How Many All Together?




Tom has one flying dinosaur. Pete has one T-Rex. How many dinosaurs do they have all together? Two.




Two cats play together. One cat joins them. Now how many cats are playing? Three.




Pete has two blocks. Tom has two blocks. How many blocks do they have together? Four.




Pete has three cars. Tom has two cars. How many cars do they have all together? Five.
